SHARE PURCHASE PLAN TERMS AND CONDITIONS

This is the terms and conditions of the Kairos Minerals Limited (ACN 006 189 331) (**Company**) 2019 Share Purchase Plan (**Offer**) and are binding on any shareholder providing a completed Share Purchase Plan Application Form to the Company.

1. Offer

The Offer is an invitation to offer to apply for fully paid ordinary shares in the Company (**Shares**) up to a maximum subscription of \$30,000 at an issue price of \$0.011 per Share (**New Shares**) (**Offer**).

The Offer to each eligible shareholder is made on the same terms and conditions.

The Offer is non-renounceable.

2. Eligibility

You are eligible to apply for New Shares (**Eligible Shareholder**) if:

- (a) your registered address in the Company's register of members is in Australia or New Zealand or any other jurisdiction where in the reasonable opinion of the Company it is lawful and practical for the Company to offer New Shares; and

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3. Issue Price

4.2 \$30,000 maximum

The total costs of New Shares purchased by each Eligible Shareholder (including through joint holding(s), multiple share accounts or any holding in which they have a beneficial interest/s) must not exceed \$30,000.

The Company reserves the right to issue to an Eligible Shareholder fewer New Shares than the number specified in an Application Form for whatever reason, including to avoid the possible subscription of over \$30,000 worth of New Shares by a shareholder through multiple applications or joint holdings.

No fractions of New Shares will be issued.

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4.3 Maximum number of New Shares to be issued

- (a) **ASX Listing Rules limitation:** In accordance with ASX Listing Rule 7.2 Exception 15, the total number of New Shares under the Offer must not exceed 30% of the number of Shares currently on issue.
- (b) **Discretionary limitation:** It is presently intended that a maximum of 59,090,909 Shares will be issued pursuant to the Offer, which would raise a maximum of \$650,000. - (a) RC drilling program (2-3,000m) predominantly at the Iron Stirrup Project, part of the Pilbara Gold Project, and potentially other deposits - commencing early November;
- (b) Review of the existing Mineral Resource at the Pilbara Gold Project (Q4 2019);
- (c) Commencement of mining studies for the Pilbara Gold Project (Q1 2020);
- (d) Initial exploration activities including drilling at the newly defined large gold-in-soils anomaly at the Croydon Project (Q2 2020); and
- (e) costs of the Offer.

As with any intended budget or use of funds, this is a statement of current intentions as at the date of this Offer. New Shares issued under the Offer will be issued as soon as practicable after the Offer closing date. Application for quotation on ASX of the New Shares will be made immediately following the issue of those Shares.

13. Joint holders
